Theodore Baskin is the principal oboist of L'Orchestre Symphonique de Montreal, where his wife is a cellist. Their son is a pianist. Theodore Baskin performed extensively all over Europe and the US and made over 70 recordings with the orchestra. The Baskin Trio program will include Maurice Ravel's Kaddish for Oboe and Piano, Serge Prokofiev's Overture on Hebrew Themes, and compositions by Pavel Haas, Beethoven, and Dmitri Shostakovich.

Leonata Trio

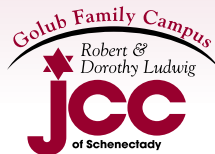
Music to Enjoy, Moments to Remember

Leo Milman was assistant concertmaster of the Minsk Chamber Orchestra and traveled around Europe performing with the orchestra. He is the string teacher at Canajoharie Central School. The trio's program will include music by Gershwin, Rubenstein, and Milman's own arrangements of beloved Israeli tunes. The musicians will also perform a variety of classical songs, including compositions by Corelli, Handel, and Mozart.

Active as pianist and composer, Max Lifchitz has performed throughout Europe, Latin America and the U.S. Lifchitz was praised by the NY Times for his "clean, measured and sensitive performances." He joined the teaching staff of The University at Albany in 1986 and has appeared as soloist with the Siena Chamber Orchestra and Albany Symphony Orchestra. His program will include piano music by 20th century Jewish composers including Aaron Copland's *El Salon Mexico*, and George Gershwin's *Rhapsody in Blue*.
