

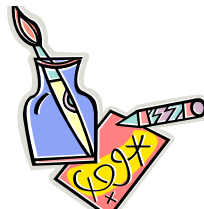

Daily Schedule

- 3:45 pm – 4:00 pm – Arrive from school and have snack

- 5:00 pm – 6:00 pm - Play games and activities until pickup.

Half-Days

MASEP provides additional care for children on Niskayuna school half-days. This is included in your fee, as long as your child is regularly scheduled to attend the program on that day.

The JCC also offers school vacation day and snow day programs. These are available at an additional charge and you must pre-register your child for each day you would like him or her to attend.
